

Live Skills - the experience of the National Institute for Research and Cultural Training (NICRT) Romania

Culturadata — Sharpening minds!

The National Institute for Cultural Research and Training (INCFC), subordinated to the Ministry of Culture, is the only national institute that aims to study, research and provide statistical data in the field of culture as well as training professionals who choose a career in this field.

In the last 5 years :

- ❑ 85 studies and statistical analyses
- ❑ 8000 trained beneficiaries coming from approximately 700 cultural institutions
- ❑ 21 published volumes
- ❑ 7500 evaluated candidates within the evaluation sessions

NICRT activities into the Live Skills activities

In order to tackle LIVE SKILLS project objectives, NICRT developed the following activities:

- ✓ Training need analyse for professions within the audiovisual and art performance among vocational students and professionals working in the field of culture;
- ✓ Adapting 3 new curricula on the basis of the projects' partners curricula structure on arts management, cultural entrepreneuriat and new digital skills;
- ✓ Alternative piloting for the vocational students and professionals working in the field of culture – 6 seminars for professionals in culture and vocational students
- ✓ Promoting new continuous training curricula among NICRT beneficiaries.

Alternative piloting in Romania

According to the training needs analyse report, NIRCT team proposed an alternative way to deliver the curricula elaborated by the project partners.

That meant:

- ❑ - Different target groups
- ✓ - Adapting curricula for the professional profile of the participants
- ✓ - Delivering 6 seminars each of 8 hours lenght on Arts management, Cultural enrepreneuriat and New digital technologies to 102 professionals working into cultural domains and vocational students.
- ✓ - A national report on the alternative piloting in Romania.

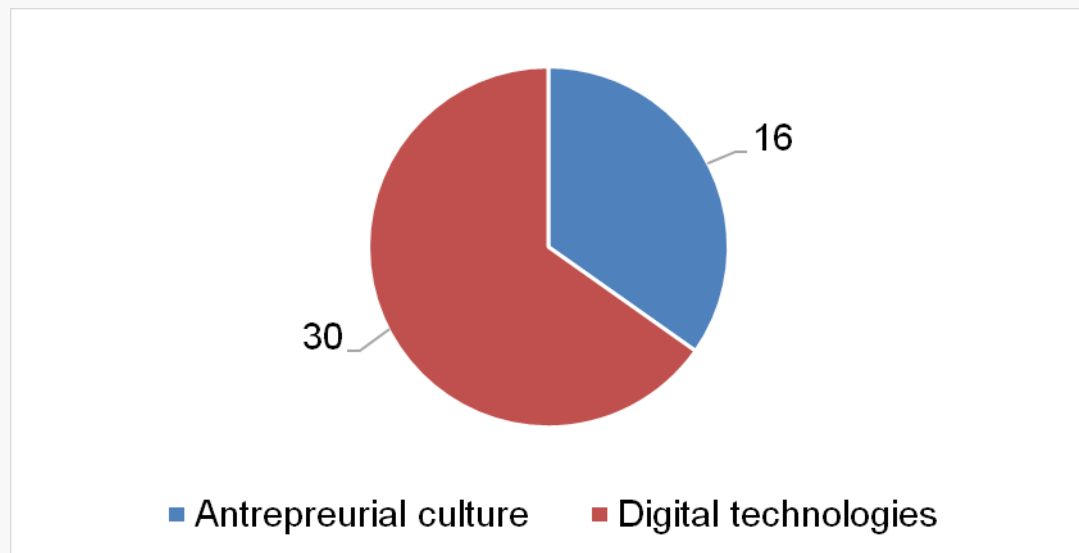
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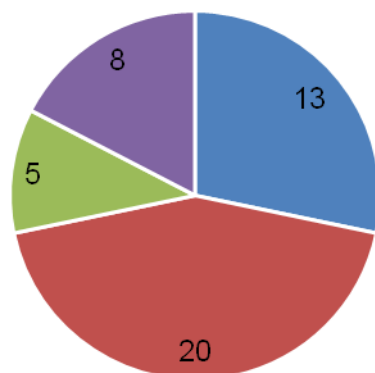
IMPACT OF THE ALTERNATIVE PILOTING IN ROMANIA

Number of responding according to the seminar theme



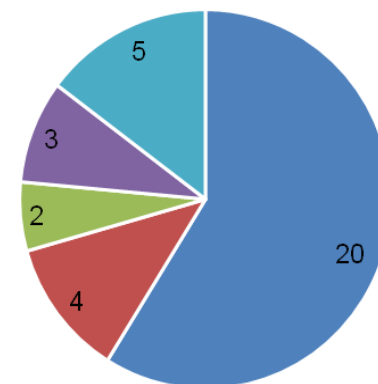
There were applied 60 questionnaires, 46 filled in, from which 30 by respondents who took part in the seminar on digital technologies and only 16 questionnaires were filled in by the attendees in the seminar on entrepreneurial culture. There were 102 participants to the seminars, of which 11 attended Cultural Management, 21 Cultural Entrepreneurship and 70 New Digital Technologies.
